As we have expanded services to encompass the before and after of women walking through a pregnancy decision, while homeless or in need of support, we have increased our experience and knowledge of working with women who have faced adverse childhood experiences, drug addiction, mental health crisis, long term sexual abuse including women escaping sexual exploitation and sex trafficking.

But in 2020 we will be focused on HOUSING. We are looking to completely underwrite the apartments moving forward. Why?



Women facing crisis continue to reach out for services, sometimes during their pregnancy and increasingly while single parenting in the aftermath of domestic violence, a long term abusive situation, mental health challenges and in general, needing a place to land and regroup.

When the rent is covered we are able to serve more women in need. We continue to work from the foundation of maternity and mother-child housing, however, we have expanded our borders to offer a safe haven to women in unique situations that have no where else to turn.

We can now say we are serving more women in different ways, at different points of need, for various lengths of stay before, during and after pregnancy.
